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### 1 Description

The **SUBCON...SH** D-SUB range comprises connectors for point-to-point connections with cable entries in 9, 15 and 25-pos. pin or socket design.

The 9-pos. version is especially suitable for INTERBUS. A whole host of further applications are opened up by having all the connections assigned to their own 1 mm<sup>2</sup> screw terminal block.

Installing the connection block either in the upper or lower shell makes it possible to enter the cable at an angle of 35° from the right or the left. The metal-plated housing also ensures high shielding against electromagnetic interference.

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# 4 Safety regulations and installation notes



#### **WARNING:**

- The category 3 device is designed for installation in zone 2 potentially explosive areas. It meets the requirements of EN 60079-0:2012 and EN 60079-15:2010.
- Installation, operation, and maintenance may only be carried out by qualified electricians. Follow the installation instructions as described. When installing and operating the device, the applicable regulations and safety directives (including national safety directives) as well as general technical regulations must be observed. The safety data is provided in the package slip and on the certificates (conformity assessment, additional approvals where applicable).
- Do not repair the device yourself; replace it with an equivalent device instead. Repairs may only be carried out by the manufacturer. The manufacturer is not liable for damage resulting from noncompliance.
- The IP20 degree of protection (IEC 60529/EN 60529)
   of the device is intended for use in a clean and dry environment. Do not subject the device to mechanical strain and/or thermal loads that exceed the specified limits.




Figure 1 Dimensions in mm




Figure 2 Design

### 5.3 Opening the housing




Figure 3 Opening the housing

### 5.4 Stripping

The following stripping tool is recommended:

- QUICK WIREFOX 6, Order No. 1204384
- Strip off the conductors. Stripping length: 5 mm

Cable entry can be from the right or left side. The connector supplied is pre-assembled for left-hand entry.

### Left-hand side cable entry




Figure 4 Left-hand side cable entry

Connect the conductors to the screw terminal blocks.

### Right-hand side cable entry




Figure 5 Right-hand side cable entry

- Lift the PCB out of the housing using a screwdriver.
- Insert the PCB in the upper housing part
- Connect the conductors to the screw terminal blocks.

### 5.6 Strain relief



You can turn the clip bracket over in order to adjust the strain relief to the cable diameter.

- Lay the shielding under the clip bracket of the strain relief and screw tight.
- Finally, close and screw tight the housing half shells.
- Attach the label.
